

In accepting this quotation the client agrees to and accepts all the terms and conditions associated with this quotation as listed below taking into account all factors which may impact on the cost of carrying out the works which is as follows:

- Quotation is based on information provided by the client and is valid for 30 days from date quoted. Quotation may be withdrawn at any time up to acceptance and may be subject to adjustment after 30 days. Any quotation made by GRL to the customer is not an offer or obligation to sell but an invitation to treat only. GRL reserves the right to accept or reject any order which may be received by it.
- In the event works quantities are larger than stipulated in the quotation then the client accepts that additional charges shall be payable and invoiced as an additional variation to the lump sum costing at the current scheduled rate. In the event the quantities are smaller than stipulated in the quotation then the lump sum quotation shall stand on the quantities as quoted and the client accepts that payment in full as per the quoted value shall be applicable.
- In the event the client requires that works become the subject of a Sub Contract agreement in accepting this quotation the client agrees and accepts to include this quotation and these project specific Terms and Conditions as part of the contract documents. In addition GRL in its absolute discretion reserve the right to vary the costing associated with this quotation to accommodate such risks and requirements presented in any sub contract document.
- This quotation is provided in good faith based on the quantities and dimensions stipulated in the body of the quotation which have been estimated in good faith from the drawings provided or provided by you the client. GRL take no responsibility for the accuracy of these quantities and as such it shall be the clients responsibility to ensure they are accurate and in accordance with their requirements.

Hours Of Work

Monday to Friday 7am - 5pm. Works outside of these hours, weekends and public holidays may incur additional charges.

Establishment Fees

Establishment fees to site is estimated on number of visits required to complete works. If additional site visits are required/requested then additional charges will apply. Re-establishment fees will apply if works are unable to be completed due to factors out of our control.

Cancellation Fees

Cancellations must be notified by 10am the previous day prior to job booking; cancellation after this time may incur additional charges.

Exclusions

Minor traffic management when at site is included in this quotation. Site specific traffic management, traffic management plans TMP and/or VicRoads MOA applications, temporary line marking, reflectivity testing or removal of redundant line marking is NOT included in this quotation.

Site Specific Additional Items

Site specific documentation/inductions and allowances are NOT included in this quotation; additional charges will apply if site specific documentation or inductions are required and/or if any site allowances are applicable.

Set out

Initial set out by qualified surveyor is NOT included in this quotation. All Roads without kerb and channel, shall require survey marks at the expense of the client. The suitability of the specification, design, plan and set out for pavement marking installation rests with the client or the designer & under no circumstances shall GRL be responsible for loss or damage to person or property or for incidental or consequential damages of any nature whether arising in tort, negligence or contract that may be associated with any such specification design, plan or set out.

Site Access and Conditions

These works are quoted in good faith with costing based on the assumption that GRL will have free, open and unrestricted access to the installation areas as per the approved plans provided stated in the quotation. No vehicular or pedestrian access will be permitted upon work areas during installation and in the event that this area is reduced or access is compromised by circumstances beyond the control of GRL then this quotation may be the subject of variation. It shall be the responsibility of the client to ensure the pavement is clean and free of construction mud, dirt and debris. In the event that the site is not clean and is deemed unsatisfactory by the GRL works supervisor, work will not proceed and additional establishment fees will be charged to the client.

Substrate Suitability

The specified pavement marking is being installed in accordance with the client's directions, hence the client acknowledges and agrees that the design and suitability of the pavement and substrate base rests with the client. In turn the client acknowledges and agrees that GRL cannot warrant the performance of any applied pavement markings if the pavement surface has, or over time develops structural defects resulting in substrate failure including but not limited to any form deterioration or cohesive failure within the substrate. Similarly performance cannot be warranted if the pavement surface is found to contain any contaminants which may be harmful to the adhesive/cohesive performance of the pavement markings including but not limited to concrete curing agents and or hydrocarbon contamination by oils and other like fuels.

Concrete Surfaces

Concrete surfaces MUST be fully cured for a period of 28 days and written confirmation from the client is required prior to line marking. Some line marking materials are not suitable for use on concrete, therefore no warranty will be offered if GRL is requested in writing to apply non suitable line marking materials to concrete surfaces.

Coloured Surface Treatments (CST)

Unless otherwise stipulated in the quotation CST is for application to standard Dense Grade Asphalt with a texture depth no greater than 0.6 mm. The client acknowledges and accepts that it is the physical nature of a liquid applied resin system to on occasions under run or "bleed" under the masking tape used to define the applied perimeters of the application at hand. GRL advises and the client accepts that all reasonable care shall be taken to ensure that any such event is minimised however due the nature of these applications, GRL cannot offer any assurances that minor resin under run will not occur and subsequently any resin under run will not be considered or accepted to be a works defect.

Authority To Commence Works

An Authority to Commence Works form, a purchase order and a suitably endorsed approved GRL credit application shall be required prior to works commencement. At the sole discretion of GRL, written confirmation of acceptance of quotation and direction to commence works may be accepted as an Authority To Commence Works.

Payment Terms

- GRL advises, and the client agrees that in accepting this quotation that neither Payment Retention nor Liquidated Damages will be applicable to the works and the client releases and indemnifies GRL in respect to any such claim.
- Unless pre-existing credit terms are in place or otherwise agreed in writing, GRL may request COD or offer a 50% deposit payable on order with remaining payment due within 7 days from date of invoice.
- Failure by any third party to make payment to you for work, which is subject of any agreement arising out of this quotation, shall not be valid grounds by your organisation for non-payment of any amount due to Geelong Regional Linemarking Pty Ltd.
